~FAMILY WORSHIP~

Parents, and especially fathers, are called to raise their children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord (Deut. 6:7; Eph. 6:4). One aspect of this calling is to faithfully lead your family in family worship. There are many ways to do that. Below are some suggested family readings and topics of conversation.

~Lord's Day, Feb. 18~

Read Mark 1:40-45. Discuss the importance of words and the importance of following them up with action.

~Monday, Feb. 19~

Read Mark 1:40-45. Discuss the societal, cultural, and physical problems facing the leper. Discuss others you may know that face similar things and pray for them. Discuss ways you can serve them.

~Tuesday, Feb. 20~

Read Mark 1:40-45. Discuss the subject of compassion. What does it mean and what does it look like in your daily life?

~Wednesday, Feb. 21~

Read Mark 1:40-45. Discuss the ways in which Christ showed compassion to the leper.

~Thursday, Feb. 22~

Read Mark 1:40-45. Discuss the ways in which Christ shows compassion to you. Make a list and spend time thanking God for those things.

~Friday, Feb. 23~

Read Mark 1:40-45. Discuss the responsibility you have as recipients of the compassion of Christ.

~Saturday, Feb. 24~

Read Mark 1:40-45. Discuss other biblical events that highlight the compassion of the Savior. *Extra:* Use the worship guide sent by the pastor on Saturday in preparation for worship on Feb. 25.
