The Westminster Confession of Faith, 21.7-8

Q. What do the Scriptures teach regarding the Lord's Day?

7. As it is the law of nature, that, in general, a due proportion of time be set apart for the worship of God; so, in his Word, by a positive, moral, and perpetual commandment binding all men in all ages, he hath particularly appointed one day in seven, for a Sabbath, to be kept holy unto him: which, from the beginning of the world to the resurrection of Christ, was the last day of the week; and, from the resurrection of Christ, was changed into the first day of the week, which, in Scripture, is called the Lord's day, and is to be continued to the end of the world, as the Christian Sabbath.

8. This Sabbath is then kept holy unto the Lord, when men, after a due preparing of their hearts, and ordering of their common affairs beforehand, do not only observe an holy rest, all the day, from their own works, words, and thoughts about their worldly employments and recreations, but also are taken up, the whole time, in the public and private exercises of his worship, and in the duties of necessity and mercy.

~FAMILY WORSHIP~

Parents, and especially fathers, are called to raise their children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord (Deut. 6:7; Eph. 6:4). One aspect of this calling is to lead your family in family worship faithfully. There are many ways to do that. Below are some suggested family readings and topics of conversation.

~Lord's Day, Apr. 21~

Read Isa. 58. What two items are mentioned in this chapter? What is God's general attitude towards the people who do these things? Why?

~Monday, Apr. 22~

Read Isa. 58. What kind of fast does God desire from his people? Isa. 58:13-14 contain to "if then" clauses. What are they?

~Tuesday, Apr. 23~

Read Isa. 58:13-14. What is the meaning of the first "if" statement? What tangible ways can you practice that as a family?

~Wednesday, Apr. 24~

Read Isa. 58:13-14. What is the meaning of the second "if" statement? How can you honor the Lord's day? How can you avoid going your own way or seeking your own pleasure? What does it mean to talk "idly"?

~Thursday, Apr. 25~

Read Isa. 58:13-14. What are the results of joyfully obeying the "if" statements (58:13)? Discuss the confidence that comes from the final clause of 58:14.

~Friday, Apr. 26~

Read Isa. 58:13-14. In what tangible ways can you take delight in the Lord's day? What promise is offered to those who do?

~Saturday, Apr. 27~

Read Isa. 58:13-14. Use the Worship Preparation Guide sent out by the pastor in preparation for worship this coming Lord's Day.
